

Dear Patrons and Friends of PGT;

The health and safety of our audiences, performers, production and front of house staff, is of the utmost importance. We are closely monitoring developments around Coronavirus (COVID-19), and we will look to Washington State Department of Health and Kitsap County Public Health for recommendations, guidance, and direction. The latest updates will be posted on our website and the Box Office and Subscription Services outgoing voicemail. Links to public health websites are listed below for more information.

Unless otherwise directed by public health officials, all performances, public programs, and events will go on as scheduled. If there are cancellations or changes to our schedule, we will notify all ticketholders by email at least 2 hours before the performance. Additionally, cancellation notices will be posted on our social media channels and outgoing voicemail.

To safeguard our audiences, performers, and staff we are implementing additional sanitation measures throughout the lobby, bathrooms, and theater before each performance as best we can in a 100 year old building. We are also increasing public access to sanitation materials (hand sanitizer and sanitizing wipes) in the lobby, dressing rooms and at the bar.

Kitsap County Public Health is currently recommending:

- **Wash hands often.**
- **Cover coughs and sneezes with an elbow or tissue.**
- **Avoid close contact with people who are sick.**
- **Clean and disinfect frequently used objects and surfaces.**
- **Stay home when sick and avoid close contact with others.**
